



# School Improvement Priorities 2023/24

**Early Writing (EY & KS1):** To build on the success of Read Write inc and adopt Early Writing schemes that ensure increased opportunities for creative writing.

**English:** To continue to focus on a consistent approach to spelling and handwriting. To build on the opportunities to develop our more able readers and a love of reading for all, ensuring all children receive a rich reading diet. To develop links between expectations in English lessons to cross curricular reading and writing.

**Maths:** To continue to develop mixed age maths teaching. To use collaborative planning to focus on oracy and recall of number facts (including Mastering Number and No Nonsense Number Facts)  
To develop maths homework from Reception to Year 6 including the use of maths games to go home.

**Prioritising Relationships :** To build on all areas of school provision to ensure there is a schedule of bespoke opportunities for building relationships with all aspects of the school community (including parent training). To use this as part of a system to support the increasing number of children with SEMH and other SEND needs.
